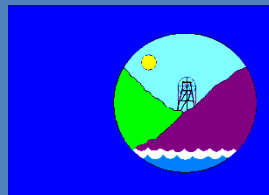

Home School Agreement

How Can I Help My Child Succeed in School?



1. Read to or with your child every night.
2. Help your child with his/her homework every night.
3. Do not talk negatively about your child's teachers or about school.
4. Make sure your child is getting plenty of sleep and is ready for school each day.
5. Teach your child to be responsible for their actions and their school work.
6. Stay involved and feel free to contact your child's teacher with any questions or concerns.
7. Ask your child about school everyday and encourage them to discuss the day.

As a school we will:

Being Ready for School	Encourage all children to wear school uniform. Make sure children and parents/carers know what days they need their PE kit.
Attendance and Punctuality	Encourage and award good attendance (above 97%) and punctuality. Follow up on any regular, persistent or unexpected absences.
Class Homework	Plan carefully and teach all aspects of the National Curriculum to meet each child's needs. Ensure that our curriculum reflects the interests of the children. Set appropriate tasks and mark work daily. Communicate with parents and give details of homework.
Behaviour	Insist on high standards of behaviour and politeness at all times both in and out of the classroom. Inform parents immediately of any persistent behavioural problems.
Concerns, Problems and Worries	Listen and respond quickly to any concerns or problems. Give emotional support when necessary.
Links with School	Hold Structured Conversations twice a year with parents/ carers. Report regularly on progress and attendance. Inform parents/ carers of any concerns or problems at school. Publish a Friday Flyer each week to inform parents of events and dates.
Extra-curricular Activities and Events	Arrange and organise an extra-curricular activity for each night of the week. Organise half termly Family Learning Afternoons for parents/carers to learn and work alongside their child. Organise regular assemblies and events to which parents, carers and families are invited.

Being Ready for School	Wear my school uniform everyday. Bring my PE kit to school everyday.
Attendance and Punctuality	Try to attend school everyday and arrive at 8.45am.
Class Homework	Listen carefully and play an active part in lessons. Work hard to do my best. Know and understand what my targets for improvement are and work hard to achieve them. Remember to complete all my homework to the best of my ability and hand it in on time.
Behaviour	Behave well in and around school and on the way to and from school. Follow the School Rules, Behaviour Policy and Anti-Bullying Policy.
Concerns, Problems and Worries	Let my teacher or teaching assistant know if I have any worries.
Links with School	Take any information, newsletters or personal letters home to my parent(s)/ carer(s) Talk to my teacher or parent(s)/ carer(s) about anything that is worrying me that might affect my school work or happiness.
Extra-curricular Activities and Events	Find out what opportunities are open to me, and ask parents/carers permission to take part in after school clubs. Once joined, attend clubs or activities regularly, letting organisers know if I cannot attend.

Being Ready for School	<p>Send my child to school wearing school uniform.</p> <p>Ensure that my child only wears stud earrings to school.</p> <p>Ensure that my child brings their PE Kit to school every day.</p> <p>Ensure that my child has a healthy packed lunch that follows school guidelines.</p>
Attendance and Punctuality	<p>Ensure that my child attends school and is punctual arriving before 8.55am.</p> <p>Telephone school by 9am if my child is absent.</p> <p>I will not take my child out of school for the purpose of a family holiday.</p>
Class Homework	<p>Take an active interest in my child's work at school.</p> <p>Encourage my child to do his/her best at school.</p> <p>Communicate with teachers regarding any problems or successes with work at school or home.</p> <p>Make sure that homework is handed in on time.</p> <p>Attend Family Learning Events hosted by my child's teacher.</p>
Behaviour	<p>Encourage my child to follow the School Rules, Behaviour Policy and Anti-Bullying Policy.</p> <p>Support the schools expectations of children's and adult's behaviour.</p> <p>Not swear or speak aggressively on the school site.</p>
Concerns, Problems and Worries	<p>Let the school know quickly of any concerns or problems that may affect my child's learning.</p>
Links with School	<p>Attend Structured Conversations.</p> <p>Read all school letters and reply as and when necessary.</p> <p>Support the school in helping my child to achieve his/her best in academic and social aspects of school.</p>
Extra-curricular Activities and Events	<p>Find out what opportunities are open to my child and encourage their participation.</p> <p>Ensure that my child attends clubs or activities regularly, letting organisers know if I cannot attend.</p>
