After weeks of planning and a detailed and robust risk assessment, school is now partially open. It has remained open to key worker and vulnerable children throughout the lock-down period and this week we have welcomed back some Y6 children. These pupils are settled in their new 'bubbles' with the same staff and next week we will welcome the Y1 children who answered 'yes' to a return before summer holidays. We also hope to safely welcome Reception and Nursery children that answered 'yes' back and will keep you all updated with details of their bubbles and arrangements as soon as we can. Please also remember parents are not allowed inside the school building, therefore, parents who have requested a place and answered 'yes' on the form, need to ensure their child is prepared for the changes for when they return.

In the meantime, we hope that all pupils at home will continue with the home learning tasks set. Families are encouraged to share their children's work so we can celebrate together. If anyone is struggling with technology at home, please contact your child's class teacher so they can support you. We will also continue to provide paper copies of home learning tasks and leave them outside school every Monday.

If your child has a place in school, please dress them in PE kit and trainers on Mondays so they can take part

If your child has a place in school, please dress them in PE kit and trainers on Mondays so they can take part in PE lessons with Mrs Bell. Government advice states that children should not get changed or bring bags from home, therefore, we request that PE kit be worn on Mondays and clean uniform where possible on all other days. (Please refer to home/school agreement)

School will close as planned for the summer holidays on **Thursday 16th July 2020**. Friday 17th July and Monday 20th July are both training days and school will be closed to ALL pupils. We will update ALL parents with the plan for September as soon as we can. At present, there are no plans to bring back any other year groups until September. We hope that school will reopen on Thursday 3rd September 2020. Parents who have children due to start Reception in September, will be contacted by Mrs Jones about arrangements and completion of forms over the coming weeks.

If you are a key worker, please remember that child care places for the following week must be booked with the school office the Friday before. Please email office@lingdale.org with your requests and we will confirm places.

We are fortunate enough to be still receiving our Greggs breakfast club funding. This means that the breakfast club hampers will continue until the end of the summer term. The hampers will be delivered by the Middlesbrough Foundation staff and school staff, where possible. The next delivery will be Wednesday 17th June so keep your eyes open! Greggs have also offered hardship grants for families that need it. If you feel you need financial support or support with anything, then please let me know how we can support you.

Please could ALL parents update us if you have changed any of the following details since March 20th;

- Phone number (or any of your child's contact numbers)
- Your address
- Any contacts you would like adding or removing from your child's contact sheets
- Any other details including medical you think we need to know in case of an emergency
- Work circumstances and whether you may be entitled to free school meals

A person with symptoms: STAY AT HOME FOR 7 DAYS & BOOK A TEST.

The rest of that household should STAY AT HOME FOR 14 DAYS (see government guidelines)

Where the child or adult tests negative, all ISOLATION ENDS and anyone connected who was in isolation returns to school or work
