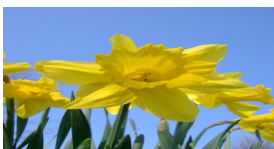
Monday 2nd November 2020—KS2 children to **arrive in uniform** and bring their PE kit in a bag for the afternoon.

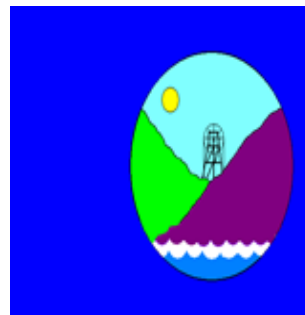
