Last week, we celebrated Maths Week England by entering a nationwide Times Table Rock Stars competition. The goal was to get as many right answers as possible by competing against pupils and schools across the country. A massive 3,887 schools, 31,039 classes and 433,924 pupils took part answering a staggering 441.93 million questions!

Out of those 3,887 schools, we finished an amazing **174th** (this includes secondary schools too!) and answered 155,459 questions correctly. Each year group from Year Two to Year Six took part with **Emily Clarke** finishing as overall winner with a staggering 18,477 correct answers!

Bobby O finished in second only 66 points behind with 18,411 and he is only in Year Three! The accolade for highest achiever in Miss Stonehouse's class went to <u>Grace Bedford</u> with 2,873 correct answers - absolutely amazing for a Year Two! Every single child deserves a huge round of applause for their efforts as to finish well within the top 200 schools taking part is an outstanding achievement for a small school like ours
