Writing

1. Grammar and punctuation - Using the definite and indefinite article - is the correct article the or a/an?
2. After looking at the non-chronological report in the reading section, can you think of different subheadings you could use to write a text about a different animal of your choice?
3. Using the example as a guide, research and write your own non-chronological report about your animal using similar vocabulary and structure.

Reading

1. Guided reading activities - one activity should be done per day over 4 days using the text in your pack.
2. Read the example non-chronological report and highlight what you notice about how the text has been broken up into sections - how do you know what each paragraph is about?

Maths:

1. Fractions and their values - Using our knowledge of numerators (the amount that is counted) and the denominator (total amount) shade in the fraction that is labelled and write the fraction that isn't shaded.
