Writing

1. Live lesson - Monday 10:30am - Non chronological reports overview and guidance
2. Grammar and punctuation - subheadings. Use the sheets about elephants. Look at the information given, cut it out and match the information to the sub-heading.
3. Using your research about biomes, decide on three subheadings you can use to guide your reader to different parts of your report.
4. Writing a non-chronological report - using adverbs of manner and joining adverbs as well as other features you have learned about.
5. Spellings - Practise the list given from the Y3-4 spelling list
6. Handwriting - practise the spelling words by putting them in a sentence.

3. Find a non-fiction book on MyOn or at home and research something you want to know more about and raise further questions about what you have read (I wonder...)

Maths:

1. Practise ordering fractions - if the denominator is the same, order by the numerators, if the denominators are different and the numerators are the same, order by denominators. There is a guidance sheet for the harder ones.
2. Competition at home - roll the dice 4 times and choose which place you will put the number (TH,H,T or O) who has the biggest number after you have both rolled it 4 times?

4. Counting in tenths problem solving.
