It is important for children to learn about different cultures and their traditions so we thought you might like to learn all about this at home this week. Use the letter sheet from the pack and copy the symbols for each letter of your name.</p>

<p>Maths Children should count forwards to 20 and then backwards daily. Order numbers 0-20. Please complete one activity from your daily maths pack each day. This week's maths activity focus: Number order. Can you cut and stick the numbers in order to make a Chinese dragon?</p>  <p>Play the number order game from https://www.topmarks.co.uk/ordering-and-sequencing/chinese-dragon-ordering</p>  <p>Added extra... Recap some addition with the Chinese new year addition sheet in your pack.</p>	<p>Phonics /Keywords: Recap all previous sounds. This week we would like you to recap the sounds taught so far over the last couple of weeks - ay, ee, igh, ow, oo. We will send video links and links to games daily through marvellous me to recap. Check how your child is doing with spelling some words with these sounds in. say, day, seen, sheep, night, blow, moon ect. Say the word and help your child to count how many sounds. We will send videos to help you practise this at home.</p> <p>Can you help the animals cross the river? Play the word building race game in your pack. Can you help the animals to cross the river by spelling words to match the picture cards?</p>			
<p>Can you make a Chinese dragon? Watch the dragon dance video from youtube https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=3tqgPo5HVts</p>  <p>Now it's time to make your own... Colour/paint the head and tail outline in your pack. Use the paper strips to fold and make a body. Can you decorate with tissue paper, feathers or crepe Paper to add to your deign?</p> 	<p>Can you make Chinese lantern? Follow the instructions in your pack to make your lantern. We have put some large paper and craft resources in your pack to help you decorate it. <p>Physical Development: Can you complete the jumping Jacks home learning challenges? See the flyer attached in your pack.</p>	<p>Cooking: Can you use your knife safely to chop some onions and peppers? Ask an adult to help you make a simple stir fry. Cook some noodles (or spaghetti if you don't have any). Can you use the chopsticks in your pack to eat them?</p>			
<p>Awe and wonder... During the festival, fireworks are used to celebrate. Can you make your own fireworks in a jar? Follow the instructions in your pack.</p>				

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
