### Writing

### Maths

- Ordering items according to their weight. Look around your house and find 3 objects then order them from heaviest to lightest. Then find 4 items and move onto 5 items. Can you find an object which is large in physical size but is light in weight? Can you find something which is small in size but is heavy in weight?
- Complete the doubling numbers sheet. Can you learn your doubles off by heart?

- Draw a number line to answer subtraction questions- see attached sheet.
