HEALTH AND SAFETY NEWS

Sadly, many bubbles in our local authority are isolating following lots of positive cases. It is a timely reminder that despite vaccinations, we need to stay vigilant about distancing, masks and hand sanitising. We have noticed lots of parents that are entering site WITHOUT their mask. September 2021

We are trying to plan for September 2021 and hope that our school will be back to normal. Please regularly check your emails to keep up to date with any plans. This will be a two night residential and we will be asking parents to make a contribution of approx. £80 per child.
