#### Health and safety update!

Please remember the school car park is for staff and visitors only. Parents/Carers must NOT park or pull in front the school gates as this is the only access route for staff and emergency services. The grey gates will also be closed and monitored between 8.15am—9am to allow our children to arrive at breakfast club safely. We also close the grey gates at 2.50pm—3.10pm to allow children to leave site safely. The green gates will be closed AT ALL TIMES!

According to Highway Code Rule 243, you should not park near a school entrance — as well as anywhere that would prevent access for emergency services, at or near a bus stop, opposite or within 10 metres of a junction, over a dropped kerb, and in front of an entrance to a property.

#### Yellow zig-zag lines

Yellow zig-zag lines outside schools indicate the length of road where stopping or waiting is strictly prohibited. You may also find an upright sign, indicating a mandatory prohibition of stopping during the times shown.
