We visited Pannett Park Museum to handle artefacts from WW1—including shrapnel from the bombing of the town and souvenirs from the hospital ship, The Rohilla, which sank off the coast in 1914. Staff from the museum have since rang school to tell us that they have NEVER welcomed such an inquisitive, polite group of children. The thirst they showed for knowledge was amazing. After enjoying a picnic lunch, we walked through the town and up the 199 steps to visit the church grounds mentioned in the book. Yesterday—on National Poetry Day—they used their experiences to write a variety of poems about the tragedies which occurred. 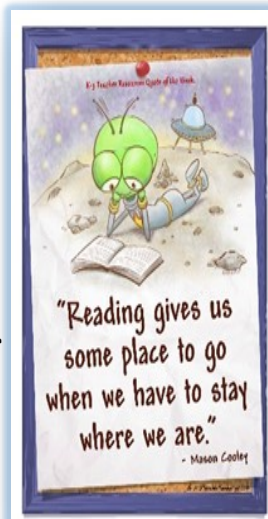
