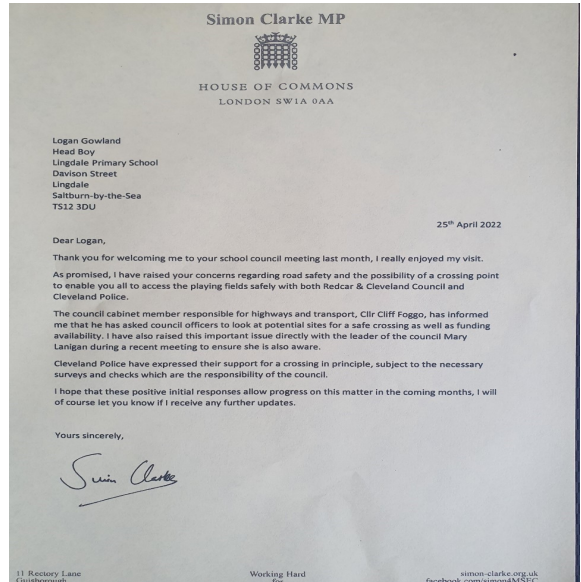


Working together to be the best we can be
