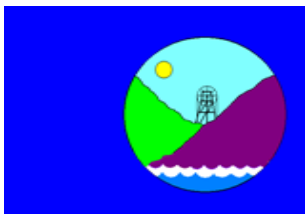
Dear Parents/Carers,

(Nursery children to attend the morning session-afternoon Nursery will be closed)

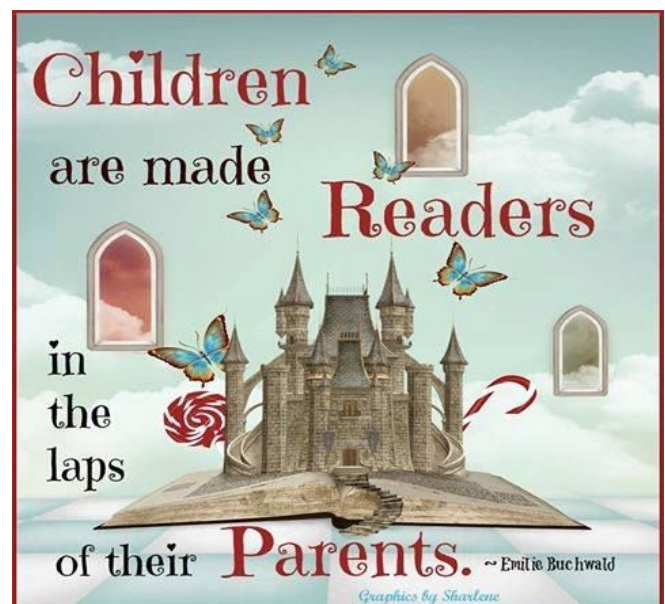
