Reading with your child at home is a crucially important way to support their learning. Reading books together, reading to your child and hearing them read are all key ways to will help your child to develop into an able reader and writer.

English

Science

We will be reading the story of Little Red Riding Hood to begin this half term.

Children will be learning to describe characters and setting using interesting vocabulary. They will be learning to sequence and write a three part simple story. Year 1 continuing to say hold, and write a sentence. They will be use simple punctuation and adjectives in their sentences and beginning to learn how to use 'and'. Year 2 will be working on using adjectives and conjunctions such as because, if, when and but. They will also learn how to use commas in a list and exclamation marks. In our Science lessons, children will be learning about animals including humans. They will begin by naming the parts of the human body and finding out which parts are linked to their different senses by carrying out different investigations. They will then begin to learn about different types of animals.

History

In History, children will be learning about the important role that Florence Nightingale and some other significant women in History played in improving our hospitals and healthcare. Children will be learning to use different sources to learn about the past and they will be making comparisons using the words now and then.



Geography

In Geography, children will be carrying out a local study using their Geographical skills and fieldwork. Children will be learning about the physical and human features of Lingdale. They will also be carrying out different fieldwork tasks around the village and beginning to learn how to read and draw simple maps.

DT/Art

Children will be learning about food handling and preparation in Design and Technology this half term. In Art, children will be learning to use embellishments during their craft and design lessons.

Computing

In computing, children will continue to learn about how to use Purple Mash and they will be using the different tools and games to support their learning in other curriculum areas. They will also begin to program a simple robot.

SMSC

The theme this term is 'Dreams and Goals.' Children will be talking about their hopes and future. After half term, children begin to talk and learn about being healthy.

R.E

During R.E lessons children will be learning about Christianity. They will learn why Jesus is important to Christians and why they celebrate Easter.

P.E

In P.E children will be practising their skills in Dance. After half term they will continue to develop their team building and ball skills.

British Values

Children will be learning about the five British values.

We will focus on the themes of respect and tolerance this term.
