
## **EYFS Toddle and picnic**

## **Sun Safety**

The weather this week has been warm and sunny. Please remember to keep your child safe in school in the sun by ensuring they have the following;



- Filled water bottle in school daily (plain water ONLY, no juice or flavoured water)
- A sun cap to wear outside
- Applied sun cream <u>before</u> school. Children can also bring a labelled bottle if they stay all day and need to reapply at lunchtime.
- Appropriate clothing (no vests or backless dresses, please ensure your child wears a t-shirt)
- Appropriate and safe foot wear (no open toe shoes please)
- On warm dry days, Crocs are allowed but <u>not on PE days</u> as trainers MUST be worn. Children will be extremely limited as to participating in many outdoor activities and won't be able to use the climbing equipment if wearing crocs. Thank you
