Communication and Language

- Responds to a two-part question
- Uses talk to express themselves
- Uses longer sentences 4-6 words
- Enjoys listening to longer stories



Physical Development

- Balances on one foot
- Makes snips with scissors
- Use large movements in a controlled way
- Develops pencil grips



Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Makes friends/plays with other children
- Shows more confidence in unfamiliar situations
- Talk about how others may be feeling



<u>Literacy</u>

- Explores a range of tools (N1)
- Sustains an interest in a story for a short period of time (N1)
- Begins to write some recognisable letters (N2)
- Writes some or all letters in first name (N2)
- Hears and says initial sounds in words (N2)

- Counts 5 objects with 1:1 correspondence (N2)
- Begins to match numerals to amounts up to 5 (N2)

Focus Stories

Our focus stories for this half term are "The Tiger Who Came To Tea" and "The Very Hungry Caterpillar". Children will be learning to explore friendships and feelings discussing how they would feel if a tiger came to tea? Should the tiger have eaten all the food? Why? Children will also learn about different minibeasts, spring and summer, and plants and flowers, through fiction and non-fiction books. We will also be celebrating the King's Coronation.

Next half term our focus story will be "There's A Shark In The Park!" This story will link to our trip to the Sea Life Centre.

N1 children will be start our Early Years speech and language programme BLAST to support the development of listening, speech, language and communication skills.

N2 children will start our Nursery RWI phonics programme.

<u>Clothing/Water bottles</u>

Children have daily access to the outdoor area so please send your child with a sun hat when the weather is warmer. Please also apply sun cream before coming to school. Please also ensure your child brings their water bottle to school everyday (water only).

<u>Reading Books</u>
