Warmer weather

English

In English, the children will continue to be inspired by a range of different texts. They will practise different writing styles, considering the context, purpose and audience of their writing.

History

In History, we will be exploring the life of Grace Darling. We will investigate who she was, when and where she lived and why she is significant.

Geography

In Geography, the children will be learning about the United Kingdom. We will explore the four different nations; England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland in more detail.

DT

In DT, the children will be learning about mechanisms.
We will be exploring how wheels and axis work in order to design and make a vehicle.

Art

In Art, we will be starting our new topic 'map it out'. The children will be experimenting with different artistic styles, such as abstract art, and will develop their printing skills.

Computing

Throughout this term, we will continue to discuss the importance of online safety. We will also explore how music can be made digitally and how we can present our ideas using spreadsheets.

PSHE

In PSHE, the children will be exploring the topic 'Relationships'. Within this topic, discussions will be based around building positive relationships, such as friendships.

RF

In RE, we will be exploring what we can learn from visiting a church. During this topic, the children will have the opportunity to visit a church!

Science

In Science, we will be exploring our new topic 'Animals including humans'

Year 1

- Exploring the characteristics of the 5 animal groups

Year 2

- ✓ Animal offspring
- Basic needs of animals including humans
- ✓ Importance of exercise, eating correctly and hygiene

PE
