## Keeping in touch

## English

In English, the children will continue to be inspired by a range of different texts. They will practise different writing styles, considering the context, purpose and audience of their writing.

# History

In History, we will be learning about Florence Nightingale and Mary Seacole. We will find out about why they are significant and will explore the similarities and differences between their lives.

## Geography

In Geography, the children will be exploring how places around the world are different. We will focus on Jamaica and will learn about Jamaica's climate, features and will make comparisons between life in Jamaica and life in the UK.



#### DT

In DT, the children will be learning about mechanisms. In this topic, the children will be designing and creating a model Ferris Wheel using a wheel and axel mechanism.

#### Art

In Art, we will be starting our new topic 'Painting and Mixed Media'. The children will develop their colour mixing skills and will experiment with different textures.

#### Science

In Science, we will be exploring our new topic 'Animals including Humans'.

Year 1 will learn about:

- ✓ the 5 animal groups
- ✓ features of animals within each group
- ✓ carnivores, herbivores and omnivores
- the internal skeletons and organs of animals
- √ the 5 senses

Year 2 will learn about:

- ✓ animal offspring
- the basic needs of animals
- the 5 food groups and what they each provide us with
- ✓ the importance of exercise and hygiene

## PE

In PE, the children will continue to develop their ball skills. They will also play a range of invasion games. In Summer 2, they will move on to athletics.
