English

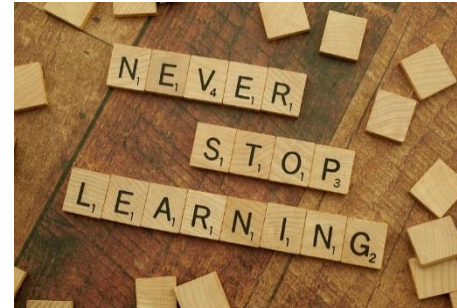
In English, the children will continue to be inspired by a range of different texts. They will practice different writing styles, considering the context, purpose and audience of their writing. Throughout this term, the children will continue to focus on securing the basics of writing, such as correct letter formation and spacing and the application of phonics.

Science

In Science, we will continue to explore our topic 'Animals including Humans'. The children will notice that animals, including humans, have offspring that grow into adults and will find out about the basic needs of animals for survival (water, food and air). They will also describe the importance for humans of exercise, eating the right amounts of different foods and hygiene. The children will also continue to develop their scientific key skills through explaining scientific vocabulary, adding labels and information to diagrams and using data, tables and graphs, including pictograms and block charts.

Geography

In Geography, the children will be learning about the United Kingdom. They will name, locate and identify characteristics of the four countries and capital cities of the United Kingdom and its surrounding seas. They will also identify seasonal and daily weather patterns in the United Kingdom.



DT

In DT, the children will learn about the importance of correct nutrition and will make their own healthy wrap. They will practice food preparation skills such as cutting, grating, snipping and spreading whilst remembering the importance of good hygiene.

Art

In Art, we will be starting our new topic 'Woven Wonders'. The children will practice skills such as cutting, knotting, threading, plaiting and weaving to create a piece of woven artwork.

Computing

Throughout this term, we will continue to discuss the importance of online safety. The children will also learn how to use technology purposefully to create digital pictures. In Spring 2, they will learn to create and debug simple algorithms.

PSHE

In PSHE, the children will be exploring the topic 'Dreams and Goals'. During this topic, the children will learn about the importance of setting ambitious, yet realistic goals. They will also explore how to effectively overcome any obstacles they may encounter on their journey to achieving their goals.

RE

In RE, we will be exploring how celebrating Passover helps Jews show God they value their special relationship with Him.

PE

In PE, the children will continue to develop their fundamental skills in gymnastic before moving on to dance in Spring 2.
