English

Throughout the year we will be providing the children with lots of exciting opportunities for using their writing skills across a variety of genres. Year 1 will be looking at saying a sentence aloud, holding a sentence, and then recording a sentence. We will also begin to use simple punctuation (capital letter and full stop) and adjectives.

Year 2 will be working on using correct word endings, descriptive vocabulary, recapping verbs, nouns, adjectives, adverbs and recognising them in a sentence.

Science

In science we will be looking closely at the human body including bones, muscles, organs, healthy lifestyles and the importance of exercise and hygiene. Alongside this we will be looking at seasonal changes.



'Marvellous me!' (Weeks 1-4)

During weeks 1-4 the children will be covering the topic, 'Marvellous me!'. We will be exploring what makes us so special. We will talk about friendship, family, our aspirations for the future and our bodies. In particular, we will look at the structure of the human body, how to stay healthy and the importance of personal and dental hygiene and exercise.

'Who is the lady with the lamp?' (Weeks 5-8)

During weeks 4-8 the children will be discovering who 'The lady with the lamp' is. There will be a mysterious item left in our class to spark the children's curiosity about the topic. This will be a history-based topic which will look closely at an event that is beyond living memory that was significant globally. Can you guess who the lady with the lamp is?



Geography

This term we will be using maps and atlases to help us name and locate the four countries that make up the United Kingdom and their capital cities. This will include looking at features from each country including typical foods, traditions, flags, and spoken languages.

History

In history we will be studying an event that is beyond living memory that was significant globally. We will look at the significant event and how this impacted on our lives today. We will also discuss famous people from our local area including Captain James Cook.

Art

Drawing and colouring skills, cutting for collages and developing techniques in painting.

We will look at different ways to move our body in time to a beat and developing our balance and co-ordination.

Computing

We will explain about e-safety, logging in, word processing, using colour magic for creating and labelling images.

P.S.H.E.

Our feelings, emotions and the importance of British values.
