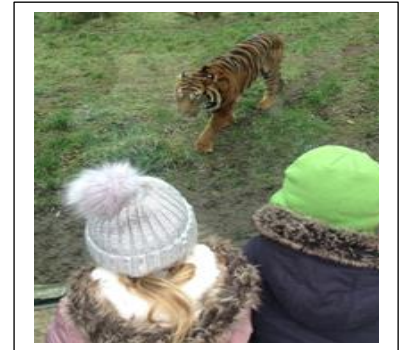
Fun at Flamingo Land
