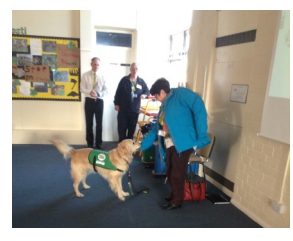
Wow! What an amazing day it has been at Lingdale Primary School.
