### Lingdale Primary School Reception Home Learning - 18.01.21

#### English -

This week's story is called the Polar Bear Paddle. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=83lqTiX\_XcY

#### Writing

Can you practise writing your full name using Rainbow writing? An adult writes your first and second name. Use different colours to practise writing over the top. If you can already write your full name, this activity is also good for learning to spell some of your keywords.



<u>Maths</u> Children should count forwards to 20 and then backwards daily. Order numbers 0-20. Please complete one activity from your daily maths pack each day.

Can you add one more? Can you find one less?
Use some small objects from home such as lego, pasta, button, small toys. Adult picks a number. Can you add one more? Can you find one less by taking away?

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Use some of the one more or one less activity sheets attached in this pack.

#### <u>Playdough</u>

Use the playdough in your pack. Roll the dice to find a number. Make that many small balls with your playdough. Squish one. Now you have one less, how many are left?

Understanding of the World - link creative and fine motor. Learn about the Polar habitat and the animals that live there. <a href="https://classroom.thenational.academy/subjects-by-key-stage/early-years-foundation-stage/subjects/understanding-the-world">https://classroom.thenational.academy/subjects-by-key-stage/early-years-foundation-stage/subjects/understanding-the-world</a> Complete a lesson each day - Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday.

In lesson one, after learning about the different Polar regions and the habitats there, the video will help you to make a model igloo. You will need a plastic bottle, marshmallows/cotton wool. In lesson two, after learning to name the animals that live in Polar habitats, the video will help you create a polar bear painting with your fingertips.

In lesson three, you will learn about how animals are adapted to the cold and use your fine motor skills to make snowflakes. You will need scissors and paper. We will send links to the lessons each day on Marvellous me to help too.

#### Discussion Questions

Pause on the front cover – what do you think the story is about? What might happen? Do you know where polar bears live?

Do you think Alfie was brave to go swimming in the sea? Can you remember who helped Alfie to swim in the sea?

Can you draw and label a picture of a polar bear. Remember to try and hear the sounds in each word to add labels.

## Phonics / Keywords:

Recap all previous sounds. The focus for this week in Phonics is ng, nk, qu. Please complete one activity from your daily pack each day. Use the read and race game attached in this pack.



You could use this spotlight activity with sound cards, word cards from activities in their packs or their keyword cards from their reading folders.
