Our new topic for this half term is 'Castles and Dragons'.

<u>Writing</u>

- 1. Watch a video of 'George and the Dragon' <u>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=RqBnO8RywaE</u> or read your own version of the story if you have it.
- 2. Create your own story board retelling the events from the story. Can you act out the story?
- 3. Join me for a live lesson on Wednesday at 11am to talk you through creating a 'Wanted' dragon poster, we will be looking at creating an adjective bank first.
- 4. Use your adjective bank from yesterday's lesson to create a 'Missing Dragon' poster.
- 5. Practise writing descending letters with their 'tummy on the line and tail hanging under'. These letters are g, j, p, q, y. Can you then write some of these as words such as egg?
- 6. Please practise the spellings below every day and then test yourself at the end of the week.

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Reading

Please read with an adult every day.

- Log onto Google Classroom to view pre-recorded phonics lessons with Miss Stonehouse.
- Do you have any dragon/castle/princess/prince themed stories to read?
- Please complete the reading comprehension attached- choose the level most appropriate.

<u>Maths</u>

- Find out what a repeating pattern is. Complete the sheet attached. Can you make any repeating patterns with objects from around the house? It can be based on shape, size or colour.
- Log on to our live lesson at 11am on Tuesday for a lesson on naming and identifying 2D shapes.
- Cut and stick activity- match the 2D shape to its description.
- Go on a shape hunt around the house- complete the sheet attached.
- Can you work out what 2D shape I am describing in the riddles?
- Draw a castle using 2D shapes- there is a guidance sheet in your home learning pack.
